Having studied our growth and satisfied with ANEW's objective of women empowerment, MSF discussed the possibility of their extensive involvement in our computer programs. After many brainstorming sessions over 6 months, we mutually arrived at an agreement wherein MSF will support our computer program.

The MOU between ANEW and MSF provides a professional approach, more employment opportunity, exposure to the corporate world for our trainees.

Mr. V.C. Kumar, COO of Mahindra Satyam Foundation visited ANEW to assess our computer program before the formal signing of the MOU between ANEW and Mahindra Satyam Foundation.

First batch of differently abled Computer trainees successfully employed

ANEW trained first batch of hearing and speech impaired women, completed their course work and graduated on the 13.11.2011.

Mr. Suresh Kamath, MD, Lasersoft distributed the certificates and delivered a motivational speech to the girls.

Among the 7 girls trained, 4 trainees have been placed at Newgen Imaging Systems Pvt Ltd, after an internship program and one of them at BalaMandir. 2 trainees are further trained in type writing skills to improve their employability.

In addition to the training program, ANEW sponsors the audiology tests for the differently abled women, to determine the level of impairment and explore further treatment/equipment options available to them.



ANEW was chosen among 35 other NGOs surveyed through Tamil Nadu for the CSR initiative of Mahindra Satyam Foundation.

Car Driving Training project

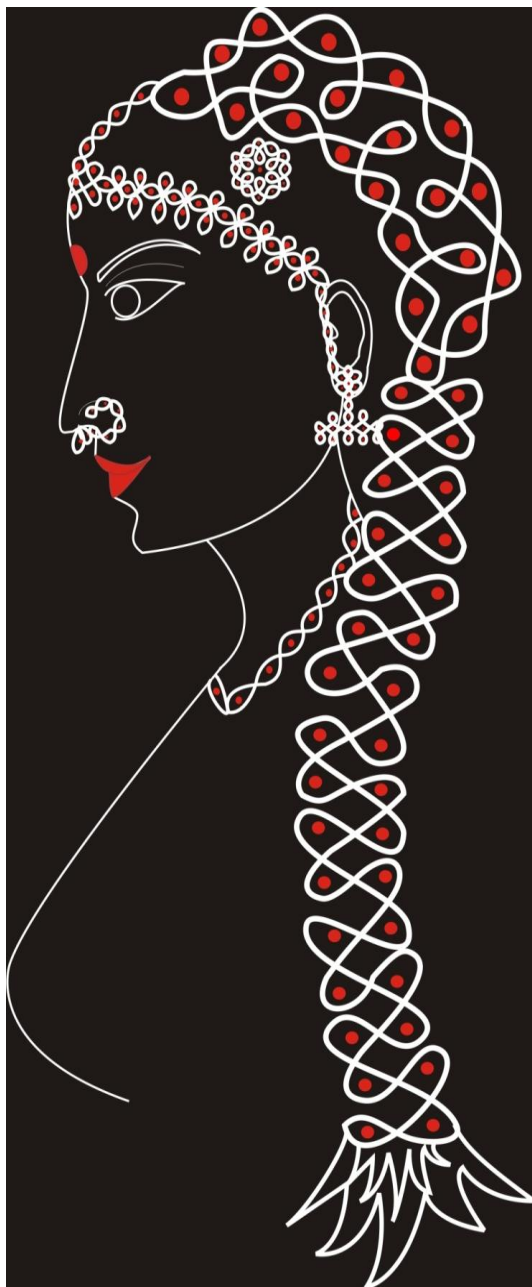
